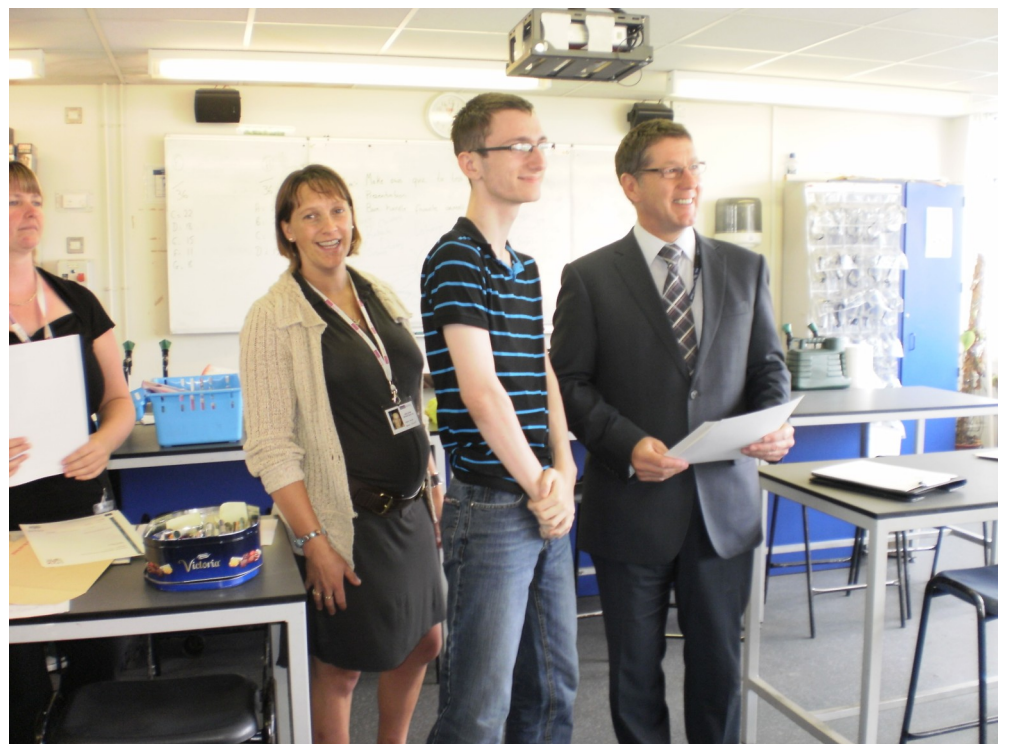
Success starts with Access...
