In August 2010 Shelby started on a foundation learning programme which consisted of an award and certificate in childcare, employability and personal development, Maths, English and I.C.T. Initially Shelby was shy and lacked confidence following issues she had at school but with the help of the tutors and the other learners she soon made friends and with this her confidence and self esteem grew. Shelby attended for three days a week and took part in various activities including looking after a virtual baby, making stories and taking part in a cooking activity. As part of the course Shelby attended a work placement at a school and received excellent feedback from the head teacher. Shelby consistently produced work to a high standard and her attendance throughout the course was fantastic.

After Shelby achieved her award and certificate she saw an advert for apprenticeships within the NHS and Access and applied. She was taken through an interview process where she was successful and completed a 2 week induction. Shelby then had to pass an interview with the NHS – which she did. Shelby has now got a 15 month contract working in the NHS as a clinical apprentice – she will have opportunities to work within the School Nursing and Health Visitor teams.
