Some 20% of your apprenticeship time will be spent on off-the-job training, consisting of a wide mix of learning in the workplace, workshops, e-learning, mentoring, self-study and the opportunity to practise new skills at work.

Apprenticeships typically last between 12 – 24 months, and our roll-on, roll-off model means there is no waiting for course start dates.
